

Glenda Scarf

This is an easy and free crochet pattern for Glenda Scarf using fan stitch.

A great project for beginners with photo tutorial in each step.

I used basic stitches like ch, dc and picot in this project.
Finished Scarf measurements: 5" x 60"

Stitch Guide:

Picot: Ch3, sl st in specified st.

Bpdc: Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back around dc post of specified dc and draw up a lp, yarn over and draw through 2 lps on hook, yarn over and draw through remaining 2 lps on hook. [BPDC made]

Materials Needed:

Hook: US-G 6/4.00MM

Yarn Weight: DK, Light Worsted

Local Yarn: Dyed yarns 6ply, 200 grams

Tapestry Needed: For weaving ends
Stitch Marker

Gauge:

4" - 17 sts x 8 rows dc

Terms Used: USA Terminology

Ch: [Chain](#) ; **Sl St:** [Slip Stitch](#) ; **Dc:** [Double Crochet](#) ;

Bpdc: [Back Post Double Crochet](#) ; **Sk:** Skip ; **Sp:** Space

Glenda Scarf Instructions

Ch5, sl st in 1st st to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), 2dc-ch2-3dc in the ring.



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Row 2: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, dc-ch4-dc in 2ch sp, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 5: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch2, sk next 2dc, bpdc in next dc, (ch3, sk next dc, bpdc in next dc) 4 times, ch2, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 3: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, dc in next dc, 7dc in next 4ch sp, dc in next dc, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 6: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, dc-ch4-dc in next 2ch sp, sk next bpdc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sk next bpdc, sc in next 3ch sp) 3 times, sk next bpdc, dc-ch4-dc in next 2ch sp, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 4: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, (dc in next dc, picot) 8 times, dc in next dc, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



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Row 7: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, dc in next dc, 7dc in next 4ch sp, dc in next dc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) twice, dc in next dc, 7dc in next 4ch sp, dc in next dc, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



1st Corner Shaping - put marker in corner for edging purposes

Row 10: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc and bpd, *sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) 3 times, dc-ch4-dc in next 2ch sp, rep * once more, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 8: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, (dc in next dc, picot) 8 times, dc in next dc, sc in next 3ch sp, ch3, sc in next 3ch sp, (dc in next dc, picot) 8 times, dc in next dc, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 11: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, *dc in next dc, 7dc in next 4ch sp, dc in next dc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) twice, rep * once more, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 9: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch2, sk next 2dc, *bpd in next dc, (ch3, sk next dc, bpd in next dc) 4 times*, ch2, sk next sc-3ch sp-sc, rep *to* once more, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



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Row 12: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, *sc in next 3ch sp, ch3, sc in next 3ch sp, (dc in next dc, picot) 8 times, dc in next dc, rep * once more, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.

Row 13: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, sk next 2dc, *ch2, sk next sc-3ch sp-sc, bpdC in next dc, (ch3, sk next dc, bpdC in next dc) 4 times, rep * once more, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 14-97: Repeat row 10-13

Row 98: Repeat row 10

Row 99: Repeat row 11

Row 100: Repeat row 12



2nd Corner Shaping - put marker in corner for edging purposes

Row 101: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, *bpdC in next dc, (ch3, sk next dc, bpdC in next dc) 4 times*, ch2, sk next sc-3ch sp-sc, rep *to* once more, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 102: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc and bpdC, sc in next 3ch sp, *(ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) 3 times*, dc-ch4-dc in next 2ch sp, rep *to* once more, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.

Row 103: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) twice, *dc in next dc, 7dc in next 4ch sp, dc in next dc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) twice, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.

Row 104: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, sc in next 3ch sp, *ch3, sc in next 3ch sp, (dc in next dc, picot) 8 times, dc in next dc, sc in next 3ch sp, ch3, sc in next 3ch sp, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



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Row 105: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, bpdc in next dc, (ch3, sk next dc, bpdc in next dc) 4 times, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.



Row 106: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc and bpdc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) 3 times, ch1, sk 2dc, 3dc in last dc.

Row 107: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, sc in next 3ch sp, (ch3, sc in next 3ch sp) twice, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.

Row 108: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sk next 2dc, sc in next 3ch sp, ch3, sc in next 3ch sp, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc.

Row 109: Ch3 (consider as 1st dc), turn, 2dc in the same st, ch1, sc in next 3ch sp, ch1, sk next 2dc, 3dc in last dc, sl st in next corner dc.



Glenda Scarf Edging

Edging Round 1: Ch1, 3sc in the same st, 2sc in the next dc post, (sc in next joined st, 2sc in next dc post) around but having 3sc in each of next 3 corners, end w/ sl st in 1st sc to join.

Edging Round 2: Ch1, sc in the same st, sc in each of next 2sc, picot, (sc in each of next 6sc, picot) around but having 3sc in 4 corners, end w/ sl st in 1st sc to join.



Fasten off and weave in ends.

sl st in next corner dc. Do not cut, continue to edging.
